

PUBLIC NOTICE

The O'Neill School Board would like the residents of old School District 2 to offer an opinion regarding what they should do with the two school buildings and land in Page, Nebraska.

A meeting was held at the Fire Hall on June 4th at 7:30 PM. At this meeting, representatives of the Page Village Board, Page Development Corporation, Improvement Club and other community leaders voted 14 to 4 in favor of demolition of the large building and saving the small building and the land for community use.

This group also decided to hold a public meeting on June 18th at 7 PM at the Page School Gym for all residents of old School District 2 who are 18 years of age or older. At 7 PM, speakers will present the proposal to the public and explain their position on the proposed vote. At 7:45 PM the following proposal will be voted on by the voters present:

“We, the residents of Old School District 2, wish to declare our desires to the O’Neill School Board by presenting the following proposal: We recommend the O’Neill School District demolish and haul away our large school building. We further recommend that they give the small school building, the land, and a few historic and necessary items to the Page Community through the Village of Page”.
